ADA Title II State and Local Government

Title II is to ensure all individuals who have a disability will have equal access to State and local government entities.

- Title II prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability.
- All activities of State and local government are included, regardless of size or if they
 receive Federal funding.
- Requires equal opportunity to benefits from all programs, services, and activities.

State and local government entities:

- Jails, prisons, and courts
- Voting
- Town meetings
- Police, sheriff, and fire departments
- Public Schools
- Public Hospitals
- Probation and parole offices
- Human services
- Motor Vehicle Division
- Public Transportation
- Any contractors working with State and local governmental agencies.

Title II protects three categories of individuals with disabilities:

- 1) Individuals who have a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities;
- 2) Individuals who have a record of a physical or mental impairment that substantially limited one or more of the individual's major life activities; and
- 3) Individuals who are regarded as having such an impairment, whether they have the impairment or not.
